It comprises:

- 50 state garden clubs and the National Capital Area
- 5,000 member garden clubs
- 175,000 members
- 60 national affiliated organizations within the United States
- 330 international affiliated organizations with locations ranging around the globe

NGC promotes the love of gardening, floral design, and civic and environmental responsibility and helps coordinate the interests and activities of state and local garden clubs in the US and abroad.

National Garden Clubs also:

- organizes, supports, arranges and delivers educational and school programs along with a variety of resources to support horticultural and environmental activities
- sponsors networking opportunities and special projects in which members can participate in order to be of service to communities on a local, regional, national and international level.

FLORIDA FEDERATION OF GARDEN CLUBS (FFGC)

Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc. is a nonprofit association for the purpose of engaging in educational, charitable and scientific activities and is composed of 235 Federated Clubs. They are headquartered in Winter Park, Florida.

Its purpose is to

- further the education of the members and the public in the fields of gardening, horticulture, botany, floral design, landscape design, environmental awareness through the conservation of the natural resources, civic beautification, nature studies, and to instill in our youth the love of gardening and the respect and protection of the environment.
- encourage the erection of memorials to veterans of the United States armed forces
- coordinate the interests of the several Garden Clubs in the State of Florida to the extent such coordination represents a furtherance of the activities specified above provided always that such purposes shall be effectuated by activities which are within the scope of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
- To do and perform all other acts and things necessary to carry out the purposes of this Corporation as a Corporation not for profit in accordance with the law in such cases made and provided.
